

The El Paso Symphony Orchestra's Tocando Music Project is an in-school and after-school program that provides music learning and performing opportunities to elementary through high school students. Tocando's mission is to empower children to improve their sense of community and opportunity. Music is used as a vehicle for children to acquire valuable tools of teamwork, self-confidence, leadership, and academic success.

Tocando began in September 2013 at Hart Elementary School in El Segundo Barrio. Tocando expanded to Guillen Middle School in 2017-2018, concentrating on schools in the feeder pattern of Bowie High School. Collaborations with UTEP create a pathway to college for students beginning in elementary school and continuing throughout their education careers.




